This small local café chain offers wonderful coffee and baked goods, and does some fine lunch-type fare as well. Try out a Messicano (\$5.25, w/ salad \$6.75) with spicy eggplant and other veg on fresh calabrese with a creamy avocado spread. The Emilia (\$5.25) has thinly-sliced prosciutto and Friulano cheese with thick slices of tomato, drizzled with olive oil on fragrant focaccia. The fresh juice selection (12oz \$3.25, 20oz \$5.25) and smoothies (12oz \$3.25, 20oz \$5.25) are healthy choices if you want to avoid caffeine (\$1.36-4.25). **JS**
